

Guidelines for the Best Student Paper Contest of ARIS 2019

Purpose

- To encourage students to participate and improve the quality of their research work.
- To promote academic and technical intercommunion among young researchers.

Important Date

- Deadline of the contest paper submission: **May 31, 2019**
- Date of finalist notification: **June 28, 2019**
- Date of the final contest: **August 22, 2019**

Guidelines

- **Eligibility:** The contestant must be an undergraduate student, MS/PhD level graduate student, or immediately BS/MS graduated less than one year. In addition, the contestant must be the first author of the contest paper.
- **Procedures:** Log in the online paper submission system at the conference website, <http://aris2019.nchu.edu.tw>. Upload your contest paper and indicate its category as "Best Student Paper Contest". The contest consists of the following two stages:
 - Preliminary Review Stage:** The quality of the contest paper will first be evaluated by the referees. The contestants of the six best papers will be selected as finalists.
 - Final stage:** The finalists need to make oral presentations in English on **August 20-23** at the time and place arranged.
- **Topics:** The subject of the contest paper must relate to the conference themes/areas as indicated on the ARIS 2019 conference website.
- **Prizes:** The first three winners will be awarded. All the first three winners and three finalists will receive a certificate of honorable mention, respectively.

Notes

- A contestant who engages in plagiarism would positively lose the right to contest, and may be subject to legal actions.
- Papers of the finalists will be included in the conference proceeding. Contest papers not successfully entering the final stage will be assessed by the referees on their possible inclusion into the conference proceeding. Please do not submit the final contest paper to other conference sessions of ARIS 2019.
